

Brookshade Pool Operational Pandemic Guidelines

May 2020

1. **Symptoms.**

If you or anyone in your household is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or if you or anyone in your household was in contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past fourteen days, you are prohibited from entering the pool area. You are required to quarantine until you meet the CDC's published isolation criteria.

2. **Social Distancing.**

Stay at least 6 feet away from any individual who is not a member of your household, **both in and out** of the pool. As a visual reference, the new fence posts are spaced 6 feet apart and can be used to maintain Social Distancing. Therefore, refrain from games or any activities that may involve physical contact. Groups larger than 10 are not allowed in one area.

3. **Tables and Chairs.**

Tables and chairs have been placed in designated spots to maintain Social Distancing and **allow groups of users**. Chairs may be moved, but please return them to their original location when leaving the pool area. Residents should clean and sanitize the table and chair before and after each use, including any common area touch surfaces. Please bring and use your own towels for use on all seating surfaces, as well as your own sanitizing chemicals and wipes. Please take all items with you when you leave.

4. **Bathroom.**

Each user is required to clean the bathroom touch surfaces, including knobs, prior to and after use.

5. **Toys, Floats, and Swim Gear.**

Do not share such personal items with non-family members.

6. **Suspected COVID-19 Exposure.**

Should a resident who visited the pool test positive for COVID-19, the pool will be closed to be cleaned and sanitized. The pool will remain closed for two days. In the event a resident suspects they were subjected to COVID-19 from another pool user, contact Pool@Brookshade.org.
